Our Christian Value for the month of **October** is **Compassion**.




News updates...



We are excited to let you know that we now have membership to Collins Big Cat books online – this is access to over 1000 fiction and non-fiction books that your child could read on a phone, tablet, iPad or laptop. Your child will be bringing home information which explains how to download the app and what their login and passwords are. This information will also be in their reading record.

Your child's class teacher will assign books to your child for them to read on a device. These books have many features – just like a kindle: they can explain words, give questions, read to the child, highlight words etc. This will be a great tool to improve your child's ability to read and for you to share in that experience.
