
Red Team: Heart (Think of people who have used their heart to inspire and care for others)

Next Week, the children will be learning and understanding feelings and emotions through zones of regulation. (see below) The classes will be using the film 'inside out' which is all about how we feel and what we can do to control and understand our feelings. This will help the children with their decision making and in making the right choice in their attitude and behaviour at school.

Here are the Zones of regulation
