Pleasant little reminders.....

Doodle is an app that the school purchase for you to use at home as part of homework and revision. Ideally the children should do 10 minutes daily on doodle. Each week the class teachers will set an activity for the children to complete at home. This will be communicated to you through the class newsletters/ text messages. It is a really valuable to tool to aid the progress and attainment of your child. Please support us at school but ensuring that your child/children complete the tasks set.









A little bit about Doodle:

• Doodle builds confidence and ability in maths and English by creating every child a personalised

work programme tailored to their strengths and weaknesses.

• Using Doodle for just 10 minutes a day is proven to help children make three months of progress in just one month!

How to get started

- 1. Watch the following video: https://vimeo.com/5061436772
- 2. . Download all of the Doodle apps (DoodleMaths, DoodleTables, DoodleEnglish and DoodleSpell) onto an Apple, Android or Amazon device.
- 3. You can also log in to the Doodle programmes through the website (doodlelearning.com) on laptops and desktops by clicking 'log in' and choosing a programme.
- 4. Follow the instructions in the video above to log in.
- 5. Use the username and password provided by your child's teacher to log in. You can use the same login details to access all four Doodle programmes.
