A message from Mrs Everard

We have continued working on our value of trust this week, especially in understanding what it means and how we can show it to others. This week in worship, I read a story to the children about an emperor, who gave all the children a seed to grow and flourish. They needed to return with the seed a year later, however the emperor had tricked them and boiled the seed. He wanted to see who was trustworthy. Many of the children returned to the emperor with plants and young trees, this meant that they had cheated- but one child returned with the original seed and no plant. The emperor said that this showed he had trust and he was the best to be chosen as the person to replace him. The other children were astounded. We talked about honesty and how even when things go wrong - we must always be honest as then others will always trust us. We reminded ourselves that God sees everything we do and our actions and words are part of us flourishing.

Our prayer this week was:

Dear Heavenly Father,

We ask that you help us as a community to follow the rules so that we can be responsible and show the adults and our friends that they can TRUST us. We know that Jesus and God sees us and we want them to trust us in the words we use and the actions we take. Help us to be responsible members of our school and live out our vision showing respect and kindness to all.


