

## School Uniform Policy and Price List

All items of clothing must be named clearly and securely.

Children should look smart, no holes in jumpers and clean shoes.

<b>School Uniform</b>	<b>Summer Uniform</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain grey pinafore dress, skirt or school trousers</li> <li>• Plain white shirt/ polo shirt</li> <li>• Royal Blue pullover or cardigan with embroidered school logo</li> <li>• White/black or grey socks or grey/black tights</li> <li>• Plain black shoes with a strap or Velcro</li> </ul> <p>Plain blue jumpers are not part of our uniform and we encourage you to purchase a jumper/cardigan with our school logo</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Light blue and white chequered summer dress (Not two piece i.e. skirt and top or playsuit styles.</li> <li>• Blue cycling shorts can be worn under summer dresses providing they do not show and are shorter than the dress)</li> <li>• White Socks &amp; black shoes</li> <li>• Grey school trousers or school short trousers (no patch pockets or combat style)</li> <li>• White polo t-shirt with logo</li> <li>• Grey socks &amp; black shoes</li> </ul> <p>School summer uniform may be worn from Easter until October half term (children can move into winter uniform earlier if weather is cold)</p>
<b>Outdoor Wear</b>	<b>PE Kit</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coats any colour (serviceable, suitable for winter) No denim</li> <li>• Coats to have a loop to hang them up by. We teach the children “hook not hood” when hanging coats up.</li> <li>• Hats/Scarves/Gloves any colour – but named</li> <li>• Rain macs/cagoules</li> <li>• Every child must have a coat to keep in their school bag. (A coat must be at school daily)</li> <li>• Book bags must have the school logo on.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Indoor kit</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Blue/Black cotton PE shorts</li> <li>• Plain white Polo Shirt</li> <li>• Black/white Plimsolls White</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Outdoor Kit</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain Blue/black Sweat Shirt</li> <li>• Plain Blue/black jogging bottoms</li> <li>• Dark Trainers (not fluorescent)</li> </ul>
<b>Hair</b>	<b>Accessories / Jewellery</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Long Hair - Long hair tied back</li> <li>• Small soft hair accessories (black, white or blue.)</li> </ul> <p>Please keep to a minimum</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Short Hair - Short, smart not closely shaven. No designer marks in hair (e.g. ticks, zigzags)</li> <li>• No hair gel for fashion purposes.</li> </ul> <p>No fashion styles. We request traditional hair styles and not designer hair styles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No mixed length hair (e.g.; Mohicans)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No jewellery in school, except for watches (worn at owner’s risk and design agreed by the school, no smart watches)</li> <li>• Earrings – only a small gold or silver simple pair of stud earrings allowed which must be removed for P.E.</li> <li>• Single studs are not permitted.</li> <li>• No nail varnish</li> <li>• No wrist bands</li> </ul>

<u>Electronic Equipment</u>	<u>What else does my child need? Other Information</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mobile phones are not allowed in school however if your child needs one for any reason it must be left at the school office at the beginning of the day and collected at the end of the day.</li> <li>• • No cameras or recording equipment.</li> </ul> <p>Children should not bring toys or electronic gadgets to school. It is easy for them to get lost or damaged. Parents are advised that valuable items should not be brought onto the premises. If such items are brought to school, it is entirely at the owner's risk.</p> <p>The Executive Head Teacher/Head of School and Governors accept no responsibility for the loss or damage of such items. The exception may be on the last day of term, if the teacher agrees. However, if a child does bring them in it is at the owner's risk.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All children may require an apron or shirt, with sleeves, for art work as requested by the class teacher.( A text message will be sent when your child needs this) EYFS/KS1 do have aprons in class.</li> <li>• PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE, ensure that everything brought to school MUST be marked or labelled clearly with your child's name.</li> <li>• Please ensure all school uniform is smart, clean and mended, e.g. buttons and sleeves etc.</li> <li>• Children must be properly dressed to represent our school in sports or performances or to go on outings or trips.</li> <li>• Any item of clothing that does not conform to St James' CE Primary dress code will need to be changed.</li> </ul>
