Local History

We have made it to ½ term and we are nearing the end of the school year and time seems to be flying by! It has been a short but wonderful term full of learning and developing. All classes have been investigating the local area through their history study and it has been lovely to see children

learn about Enfield and the surrounding areas, and why they are important historical events that changed Enfield. This week our Year 2 went to Forty Hall; Year 4 went to Whitewebbs House and Year 3 went to see the 'Eleanor Cross'. A week full of activities and learning - so please ask your child about what they have learnt this term and maybe take a visit to some of these important places.

We also this week had worship led by year 2, they told us about courage and how you need courage in lots of different situations and how God can guide and support you in not being scared when you are nervous and worried. 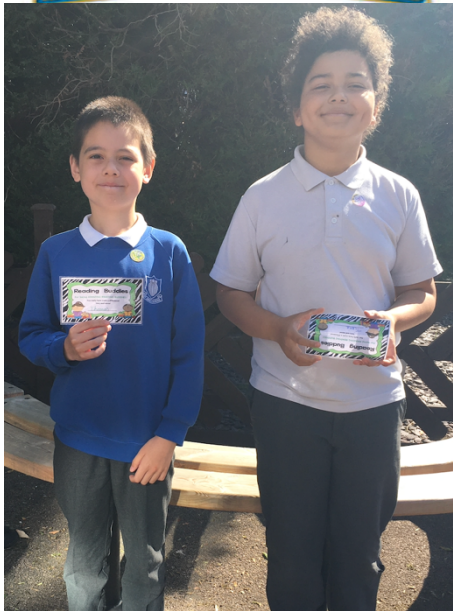

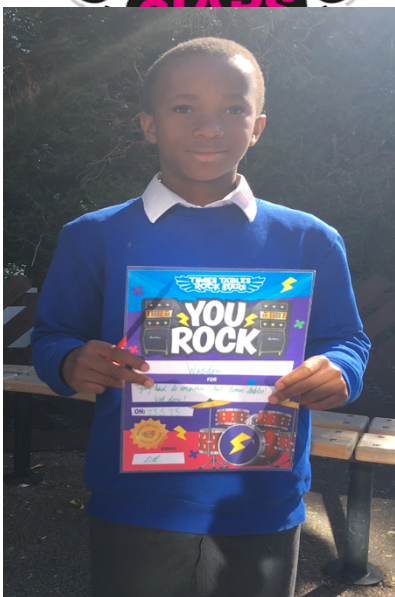


Little WANDler of the week

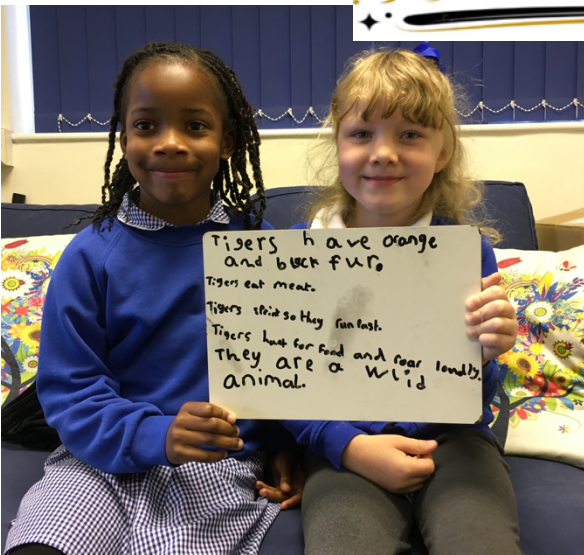
